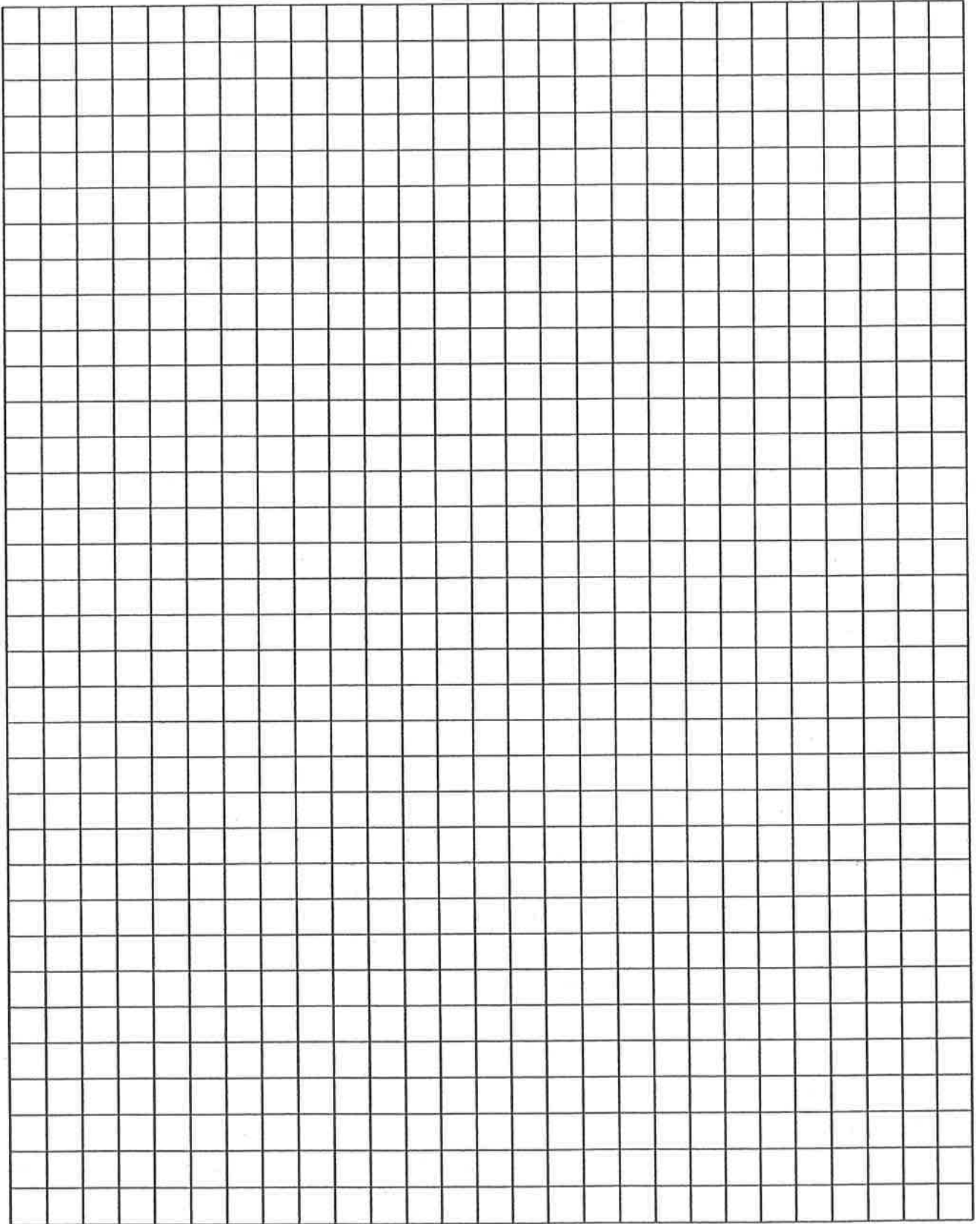
Floor Plans

Decorating for Others

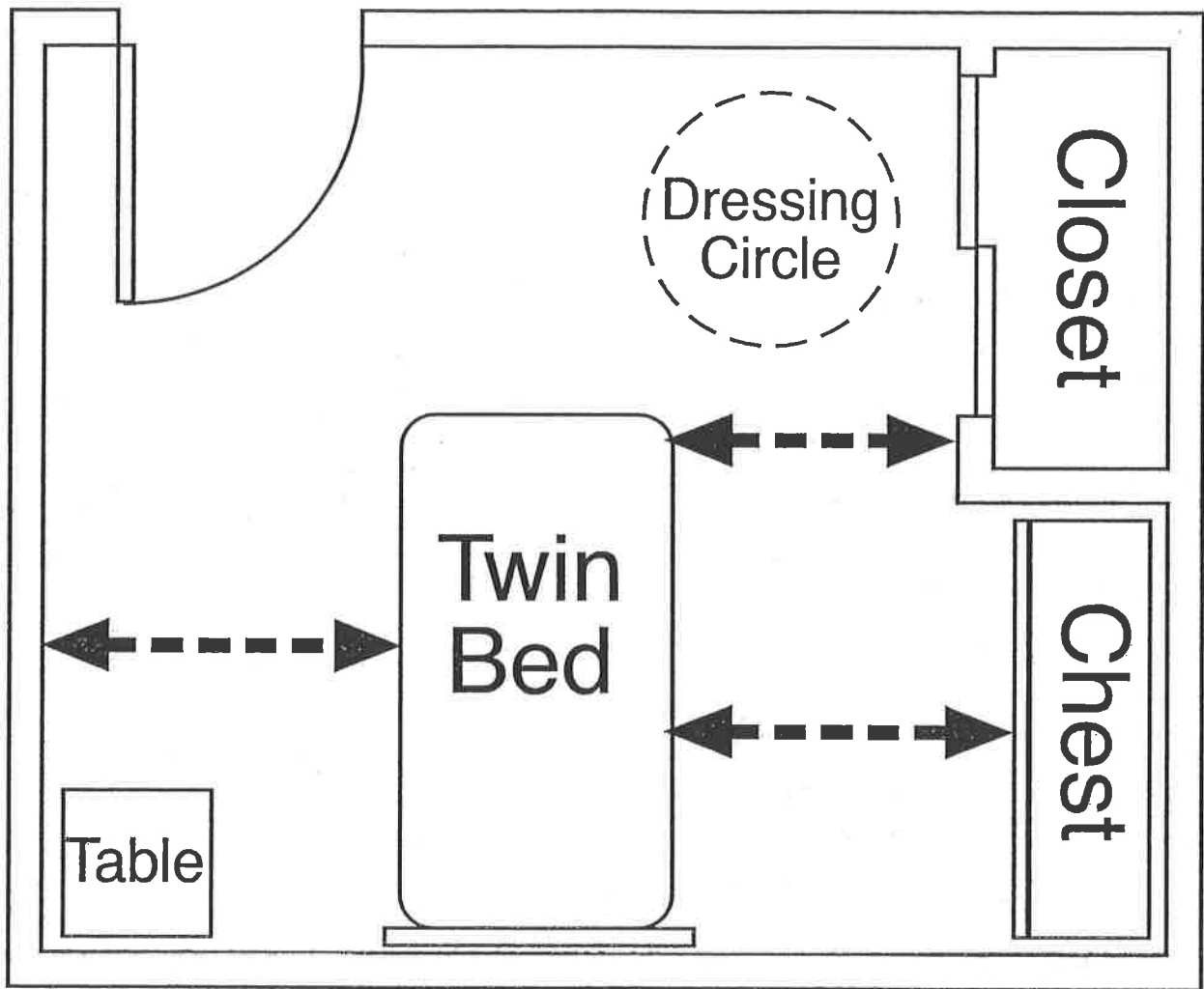

Floor Plan



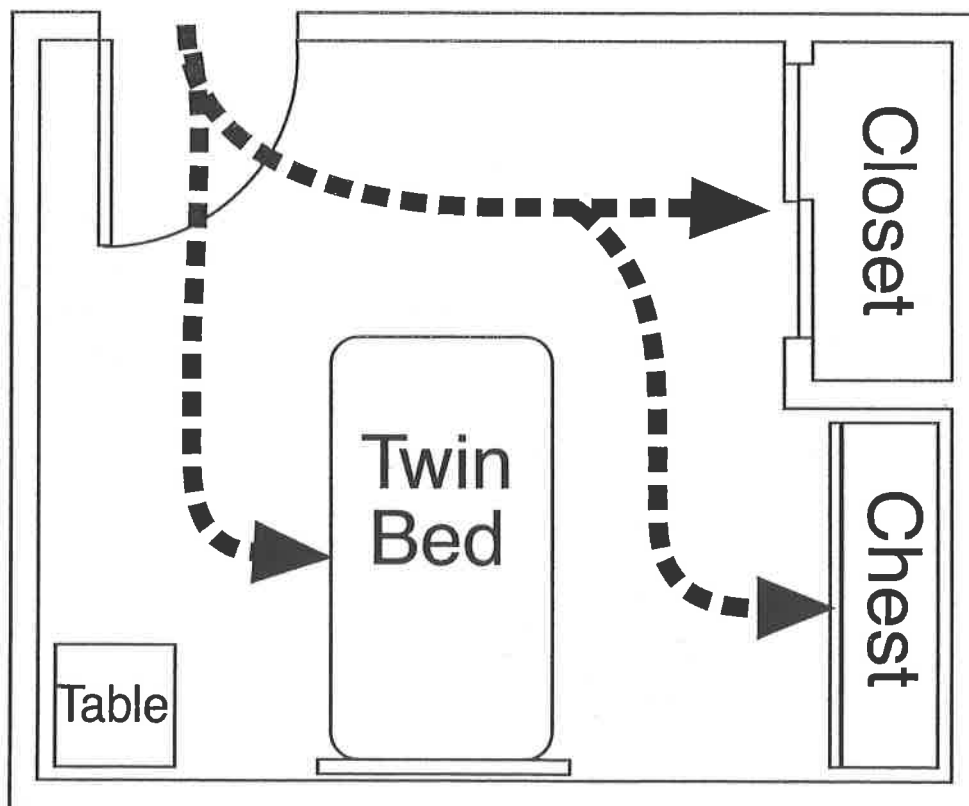
Standard Clearance Space for a Bedroom



- Space between twin beds 1.5-3 feet
- Space around any bed 1.5-3 feet
- Space between dresser and bed 3 feet
- Space to pull out drawer 3 feet
- Dressing area 3 feet
- Space in front of closet 30 inches

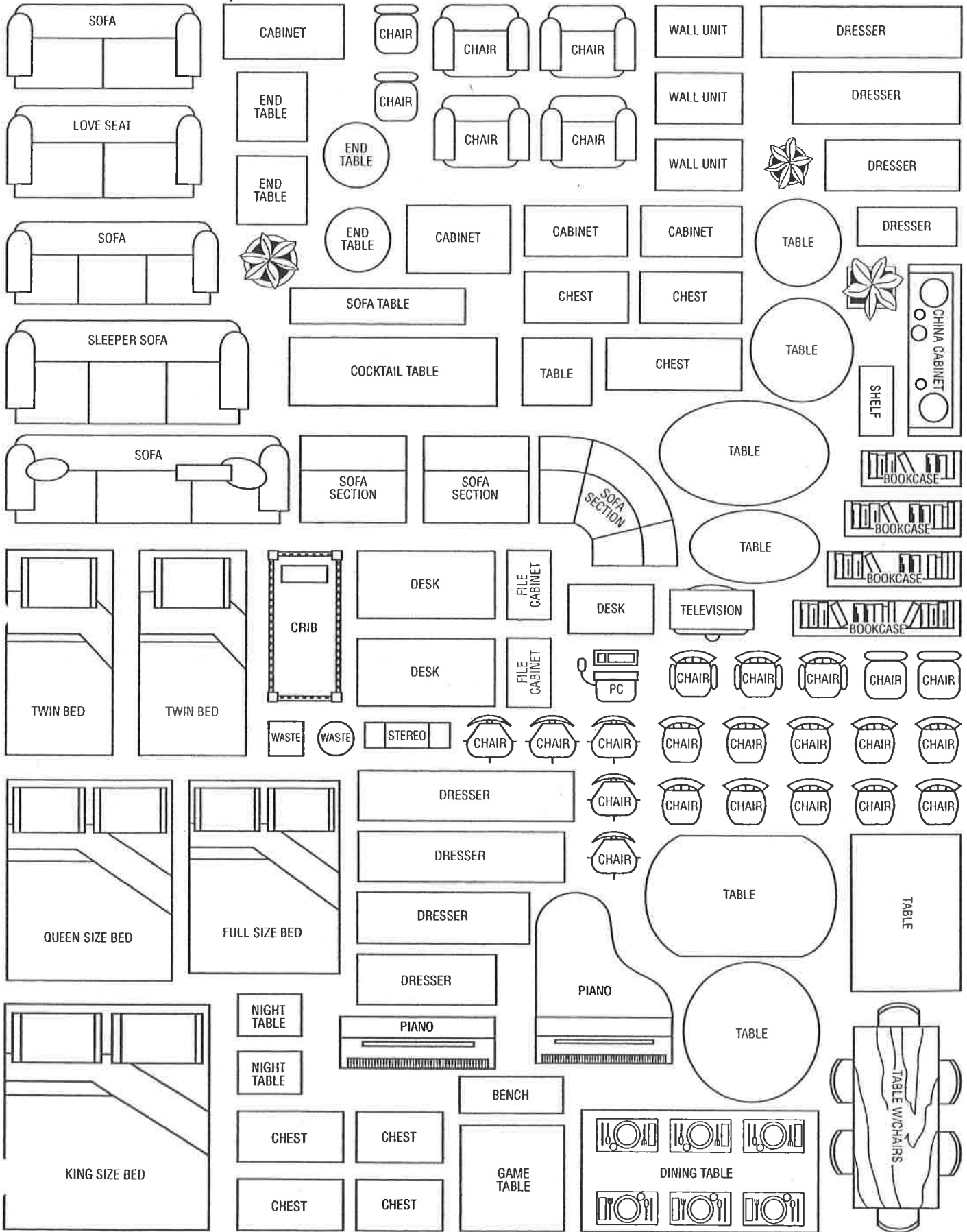
Traffic Pattern Guidelines for a Bedroom

- Place the bed first.
- Plan adequate clearance space for traffic areas.
- The traffic flow should be direct and convenient — not an obstacle course of furniture.
- Plan a focal point or center of interest.
- Furniture should be functional as well as attractive.
- Do not over furnish a room. Too little furniture is better than too much.
- Move furniture templates and experiment until groupings and traffic patterns are satisfactory.
